At Karluk Manor and 325 E 3rd Avenue, the Rural Alaska Community Action Program (RurAL CAP) prioritizes the applications of chronically homeless individuals on the coordinated entry list. Those who qualify pay rent based on 30% of their income.

Application Process

- 1. Complete an assessment at one of the locations on the left to get your name on the coordinated entry list.
- 2. After the test, wait to hear from us. When we contact you depends on how long you've been homeless and how you scored on the assessment. In order to ensure you get considered, keep your current contact information at Brother Francis Shelter.
- 3. Once you've been selected, we require that you take a Vulnerability Assessment Test (VAT) to ensure that you meet our qualifications.
- 4. If you qualify, we will assist you with gathering the necessary documents and information. To speed up the process, have your Social Security Card and Driver's License on hand.
