

1. Narrative Proposal

- a. Proposed activities are well developed, reasonable and support program intent. **(10 pts)**
- b. Plan for staffing and volunteers is reasonable. **(10 pts)**
- c. Ability and descriptive plan to oversee and monitor the project for successful and timely completion. **(5 pts)**
- d. A clearly articulated timeline for project tasks and a description of roles and responsibilities of the applicant in carrying out the project components/tasks. **(10 pts)**

- e. The project aligns with identified social determinants of health and clearly identifies and meets the intent of the RFP. **(20 pts)**
- f. The project incorporates culturally-appropriate practices or ways of achieving goals. **(10 pts)**

2. Budget & Budget Narrative

- a. Reasonableness of the budget and estimated funding amounts for each project component/task. Adequate information provided in the detailed budget. Proposed costs are reasonable, cost-effective and allowable. **(15 pts)**

3. Community Support

- a. Is there demonstrated support for the project from the community? Exhibit willingness, creativity, and dedication to partnering with available resources to complete the projects. Project shows plan to network with other service providers. **(20 pts)**
